Open Stage Performances - Terms & Conditions

PLEASE RETAIN FOR YOUR RECORDS

These terms and conditions apply to your proposed open stage performance at RAQS BRITANNIA 2010. Please read through these terms. By signing and returning the attached form you will indicate that you have agreed to be bound by these terms. Please also note that although every effort is made to accommodate attendees, we cannot guarantee that all registrants will obtain a performance slot.

The reservation of your open stage slot is conditional upon the completion and return of the attached information sheet. In the event this form is not returned within three (3) weeks of your receipt (or no less than two (2) weeks prior to the commencement of the festival, whichever is the sooner) your slot will be released and will be free again for general booking. If you become aware of any reason why the requested information cannot be provided within this timeframe, and still wish to perform, you must notify us promptly.

Please note that the open stage at RAQS BRITANNIA 2010 is an all age event intended primarily to showcase the dance and choreography skills of the many talented individuals within the Bellydance community. When choosing your performance title and style, please consider whether RAQS BRITANNIA is the appropriate forum for your showcase. BDSS may at its discretion elect to cancel without notice or require alterations to an open stage performance if, in its reasonable opinion, the proposed performance is excessively provocative, or otherwise inconsistent with the overreaching aesthetic of Bellydance (as it is generally recognised) or the aims and objectives of the festival. If you are in any doubt, please contact our London office (020 7456 8905 or email admin@raqsbritannia.co.uk).

In order to accommodate all participants wishing to perform as part of the open stage event, each performer will be allotted to a maximum period of five (5) minutes in which to perform their showcase. Any extension to this time limit is subject to the sole discretion of the stage managers. Your performance is liable to be cut short without notice if you do not seek prior approval of the stage managers to perform in excess of your allotted time.

All performance showcases offered at RAQS BRITANNIA 2010 are intended for people who are in robust health. Make sure you have completed your regular stretching routine before commencing your performance and, to reduce risk of injury, never force or strain yourself. Although we strive to provide a safe environment for all participants, you must accept the risk of injury or damage commensurate with an open stage performance in a public venue. Bellydance Superstars, Inc. ("BDSS"), its officers, employees and agents hereby disclaim any liability or loss, to the extent permitted by law, in connection with your performance at RAQS BRITANNIA 2010.

In no event shall BDSS, its officers, employees and agents be liable for any special, indirect or consequential damage arising out of your access or use, or inability to use, the facilities and materials provided. You hereby waive, to the extent permitted by law, any and all claims against us and our agents arising out of your participation in the open stage performances attributable to negligence on your part or your breach of these terms.

Please note that the use of swords and pyrotechnics is strictly prohibited at all times.

When attending RAQS BRITANNIA 2010 please be aware that you are entering a venue where photography and video recording may occur. By entering the venue, you consent to your inclusion in photographs and/or video recordings made during the event and their subsequent use in newsreels, web casts, promotional material, advertising, and inclusion on websites operated by BDSS. By entering the venue you further waive all rights you may have to claims for royalties or other compensation in connection with BDSS's use of such material, and release BDSS from any obligation to seek your approval of any photo, video and/or audio recording used for the purposes described above. You release BDSS, its officers, employees and agents, from any liability arising in connection with the taking, recording, digitising and publication of photographs and video recordings made at RAQS BRITANNIA 2010

BDSS and its agents reserve the right to refuse admission to the festival for any reason and may on occasion conduct security searches to ensure the safety of all attending.

Under-16s are welcome to perform at RAQS BRITANNIA 2010 but must be accompanied by a consenting adult at all times.

BDSS cannot accept responsibility for the loss or damage of personal property brought into the venue. Please take extra care of your personal possessions during the event and do not leave bags or clothing unattended at any time.

These terms and conditions shall be subject only to the laws of England and Wales which shall exclusively govern the interpretation, application and effect of all the above permissions, exclusions and conditions of use.
